Digital Photography

Digital technology dramatically alters the accessibility and possibilities of photography. The Specialized Program in Digital Photography explores the essentials of digital imaging, including getting the most out of new technologies. You also deepen your understanding of the aesthetics and pictorial strategies of photography. The curriculum provides the opportunity to expand your perceptual awareness and technical range so you can confidently produce images that express your artistic vision.

3 Required Courses, Minimum of 2 Electives*
10 Semester Units, 150 Hours of Instruction

Digital Photography Fundamentals ARCH X405 (2 semester units)

Receive one-on-one time with the instructor to better understand your particular digital camera.

Digital Photography Intermediate ARCH X405.2 (2 semester units)

Learn additional skills and terminology, including RAW, file work flow, color management and how to prepare files for output.

Digital Photography in Practice and Context ARCH X405.7 (2 semester units)

Develop your conceptual ideas, critique the work of peers, and locate your work in the context of broader photographic practice.

Prerequisites for Admission

There are no prerequisites for the Specialized Program in Digital Photography, but a bachelor's degree is recommended.

Curriculum and Completion Requirements

The curriculum comprises 3 required courses and a minimum of 2 electives for a total of 10 semester units (150 hours of instruction). Candidates must pay a nonrefundable program registration fee.

You must take all courses for a letter grade. To receive the Award of Completion, you must maintain an overall minimum 2.0 grade point average, with a grade of C or better in each course.

All coursework must be completed within two years of registering for the program. However, requirements may be updated based on new developments in the field of study; we recommend completing the curriculum in a timely fashion.
